Thanks for your email. The points I had made last Thursday were as follows:

1. Supported other delegations who articulated the importance of the link between this section on actions to the section on international cooperation;

2. That the chapeau in para 13 should explicitly mention the need to address concrete actions to address gaps in implementation from the HFA, and to then include such actions in the following paragraphs;

3. Having acknowledged the magnitude of the climate risks of disaster, we need to now mention action to address such climate risk, by including action on factors known to be climate risks. One concrete example is to mention the need to focus on climate-resilient infrastructure in the paragraphs mentioning infrastructure 17c and 17m. There may be others which technical experts will be able to include in appropriate paragraphs.

Trust this is useful.
